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Lorin Scher, MD, is a professor and vice-chair in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences and the Roy T. Brophy Endowed Chair at the UC Davis School of Medicine. He specializes in trauma-related illness, emergency psychiatry, primary care psychiatry, integrated behavioral health, neuropsychiatry, and hospital-based psychiatry. Dr. Scher directs behavioral health integration services across UC Davis Health's ambulatory care network and affiliates, serves as medical director for Government and Community Relations, and co-directs the Huntington's Disease

Center of Excellence. Since 2012, he has helped lead efforts to integrate behavioral health into primary care and specialty settings through screening, stepped-care interventions, collaborative care, telepsychiatry, case management, and embedded psychiatric consultation. He oversees medical education efforts in the department and teaches medical students, residents, fellows, and allied health professionals. Dr. Scher completed psychiatry residency at New York-Presbyterian Hospital/Weill Cornell and a consultation-liaison psychiatry fellowship at UC Davis.
