Resources Spotlight: Addiction Medicine Fellowship Scholarship Opportunity

The [UC Irvine School of Medicine offers the Train New Trainers \(TNT\) Primary Care – Training and Education in Addiction Medicine \(PC-TEAM\) Fellowship](#) is a one-year, part-time hybrid program designed for psychiatrists, primary care clinicians, and residents seeking advanced training in Addiction Medicine, integrated behavioral health, and academic or clinical leadership. **Applications are open and full-tuition scholarships are available for qualifying California providers.**

- Scholarships are funded by the California Department of Health Care Access and Information (HCAI) and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis following acceptance into the TNT Fellowship.
- Eligibility highlights include:
 - MD, DO, NP, PA, or PharmD practicing in psychiatry or primary care
 - Employment at a qualifying California practice site (FQHC/FQHC Look-Alike, Health Professional Shortage Area-Primary Care (HPSA-PC), or Primary Care Shortage Area (PCSA)
 - At least 50% of patients from medically underserved populations
 - Currently serve or plan to serve children and youth age 25 or younger
